Relationships deepen and darken, tinged by addiction, success and pride. Their greatest challenge is the center of their gravity, Jude an increasingly broken man.

Black Cake - Two estranged siblings must set aside their differences to deal with their mother's death and her hidden past -- a journey that takes them from the Caribbean to London to California and ends with her famous black cake. A story of how the inheritance of betrayals, secrets, memories and even names, can shape relationships and history.

Come & Get It - Millie Cousins, a senior resident assistant at the University of Arkansas, wants to graduate, get a job, and buy a house. When Agatha Paul, a visiting professor and writer, offers Millie an easy yet unusual opportunity, she jumps at the chance. But, Millie's hustle becomes jeopardized by new friends, dorm pranks and illicit intrigue.

Hello Beautiful - William Waters grew up in a home silenced by tragedy. It is a relief when he is offered a basketball scholarship at a college far away from home. Their he meets Julia Padavano, a spirited and ambitious young women who surprises him with her acceptance. When a darkness from William's past surfaces, a catastrophic family rift changes their lives for generations.

Pineapple Street - A deliciously funny, sharply observed novel of family, wealth, love and tennis. This zeitgeisty debut follows three women in an old Brooklyn Heights clan. Rife with the indulgent pleasures of affluent WASPS in New York and full of recognizable if fallible characters, along with a couple of appalling ones! A scintillating, wryly comic novel of race, class, wealth and privilege in an age that disdains all of it.

Reef Road - When a severed hand washes ashore in the wealthy enclave of Palm Beach, a young woman whose life seems perfect until her family goes missing and a writer lives alone with her dog and collects arcane murder statistics, collide. What each of them stand to lose as they sneak around the do-not-enter tape is exposed by the tightening of the cincture encircling them.

Remarkably Bright Creatures - After Tova Sullivan's husband dies, she began working the night shift at the Sowell Bay Aquarium, keeping busy in order to cope, which she has done since her son vanished over thirty years ago. Tova becomes acquainted with Marcellus, a giant Pacific octopus who knows more than anyone can imagine.

The Bee Sting - The Barnes family is in trouble. Instead of facing the truth that his car business is going under, Dickie spends his days in the woods, building an apocalypse-proof bunker with a renegade handy man. His wife is selling her jewelry and their teenage daughter is binge-drinking her way through finals while their son finalizes his plan to run away. Where did it all go wrong? Is there still time to find a happy ending?

Tomorrow, Tomorrow and Tomorrow - A modern love story between two childhood friends, Sam and Sadie, who reunite as adults to create video games. The two find an intimacy in digital worlds that eludes them in their real lives.

You Made a Fool of Death with Your Beauty - Feyi Adekola wants to learn how to be alive again after an accident killed the love of her life five years ago. Feyi's friend Joy insists it's time to hit the dating scene again but Feyi isn't ready for anything serious. A steamy encounter at a rooftop party cascades into a whirlwind summer she never imagined.
